You must know how to remove and replace your stock exhaust in order to install this product otherwise have it installed by a professional mechanic. Keep all stock parts from your existing system as some components may be necessary to install your new Yoshimura exhaust depending on the application. Read through all instructions before beginning installation. Exhaust system can be extremely hot. Let motorcycle cool down before beginning installation. Always wear hand and eye protection and take precautionary measures to avoid injury.

Tools Needed:

12mm socket Ratchet and extension 12mm and 14mm wrench Torque wrench

Installation Steps:

- 1 Remove stock muffler and gasket. (See Fig.1)
- 2 Loosen tail-pipe bolt at chassis mount (See Fig.1)
- 3 Install new muffler gasket. (Not supplied - Suzuki part no. 14181-02F00)
- 4 Install Yoshimura muffler using supplied bolts. Torque bolts to 2.5 kg-m (18 lb-ft).

Note: If you are looking directly at the four holes that connect the tailpipe to the muffler, the 16mm bolt will be used in the upper left corner. Use the 20mm bolts for the remaining 3 bolt holes.

- 5 Apply heat insulator to inside of muffler clamp and slide clamp onto muffler. (Note direction of clamp in Fig. 3)
- 6 Mount clamp to outside of stock muffler bracket using stock bolt, washer, and nut. (see Fig. 3)
 Torque bolt to 2.3 kg-m (16 lb-ft)
- 7 Tighten tail-pipe bolt at chassis mount. Torque bolt to 2.5 kg-m (18 lb-ft)
- 8 Before starting the motorcycle, check for proper clearance between new muffler and motorcycle. (i.e. swing-arm, passenger foot-peg, rear wheel, etc.) If any problem is found, please carefully follow through the installation steps again. If problem still persists, please call Yoshimura tech. Dept. at (800)634-9166 / in CA (909)628-4722.

NOTE: After starting motorcycle, it is normal for new muffler to emit smoke until oil residue burns off.





